Grading System

Pokhara University follows a four-point letter grade system. Letter grades awarded for the undergraduate levels are as follows:

The performance of student is evaluated in terms of two indices:

- Semester Grade Point Average (SGPA)
- Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA)

SGPA : Total Honor points earned in semester, Total number of credits registered in a semester

CGPA : Total honor points earned, Total number of credits completed



Degree with Distinction

To obtain a degree with distinction, a student must obtain a CGPA of 3.60 or better in the undergraduate level and 3.75 or better in the graduate level.

Dean's List

The Dean's List recognizes outstanding academic performance. To qualify, a student must obtain a CGPA of at least 3.70 in the undergraduate level and 3.80 in the graduate level.

Dismissal from the Program

A student is normally expected to obtain a CGPA of 2.0 in the undergraduate level and 2.0 in the graduate level. The student, whose performance in the past semesters does not show the possibility of maintaining this CGPA, may be dismissed from the program.
